GB/Dec06/04 Indian Academy of Neurology and NSI should Organize a joint workshop in the middle of 2006 to draw definite guidelines for training in Neurology and should make recommendation.

GB/Dec06/05 Dr. Thomas Joseph raised the issue of giving address list of NSI members of payment and it was decided that one CD each of corrected address should be provided in Delegate kit free of charge to every member annually.

GB/Dec06/07 Gaurie Devi informed the hours that 45 years of Neurology India issues are already available in CD.

GB/Dec06/08 Dr. Jai kumar suggested linking of kerala website to the main Website.

GB/Dec06/09 Dr. Ramchandran Nair stressed interest on increasing the chances of NSI with other regional Neurological societies in North and South and to increase the number of members in EC and coordination with other societies. However, Dr. Bhattacharya suggested that Zonal representation in the EC is not required and on this issue President expressed his desire that NSI is one society and it should stand united and there is no need of Zonal representation in the present time.
