Prof. Achal Kumar Srivastava completed his MBBS, MD (Medicine) from M.L.N. Medical College, Allahabad and DM (Neurology) from AIIMS, New Delhi. From year 2001, he heads Clinical Neurophysiology facility and Ataxia Clinic at the Neuroscience Center at AIIMS, New Delhi. He is recipient of more than 25 paper presentation awards and has more than 80 peer reviewed publications in international and national journals. He has received outstanding paper presentation award from AINA at AAN conference at San Francisco in 2004. He is Editorial board member and Reviewer of several International Journals of repute.
