Dr Satnam Singh Chhabra, did his MBBS and MS in general surgery from King George's Medical college and M.Ch. in neurosurgery from Sanjay Gandhi PGIMS, Lucknow in 1991. He is presently working as Chairman of Department of Neurosurgery and Member of Board of Management, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi.

He has a special interest in Endoscopic Brain and Spine surgery which he has been practicing since 1999. He has performed nearly 2000 endoscopic neurosurgical procedures that includes around 300 endoscopic trans-nasal skull base surgery and more than 1600 endoscopic spinal surgeries.

He received the Best Scientific Program Award (2005), Distinguished Services Award for noteworthy contribution to medicine in India (2004) from Delhi Medical Association. He has also received "Nagrik Samman" award by JCI Bareilly 2012

**Contribution to Neurosciences:** He has designed a new trocar for endoscopic disc surgery which he has been using for more than 10 years. The design of this trocar has been submitted for patent rights and it has been launched commercially by AVM surgicals.

He organized Endoscopic Neurosurgery Workshop in 2001 with Prof Pernecky as an international faculty and Annual Conference of Delhi Neurological Association in 2010
